1.About Whitley College.

i. General Information.

Whitley College has a proud history as the Baptist College of Victoria. For over 100 years we have been helping people to grow in faith and knowledge- loving God with heart, mind and soul. At Whitley we are passionate about: *Formation for ministry- for all God's people.*

The training that we offer for the 12 Watts internship is at both Associate Diploma and Diploma level. The Associate Diploma consists of seven units that will all be offered in 2009. If you would like to do further training at Whitley (or any other Recognised Teaching Institutions at the Melbourne College of Divinity), credit can be received from the Associate Diploma in Ministry towards a Ministry Diploma. To receive four units credit towards a Bachelor of Theology students need to have a credit average across their seven Associate Diploma units.

Alternatively you may decide to undertake a Diploma of Ministry which consists of 16 units (this can be articulated to 8 units credit towards a Bachelor of Theology provided that you have a credit average across your units).

Our vision is that through this educational experience you will learn more about God, others and yourself and in this way continue to grow in your service for the Lord.
